

S&P Capital IQ's Searching Shortcuts

COMPANY SEARCH



Enter the company's name and click the button. You may use partial spelling when searching by name.

To Search By:

- Ticker Symbol: Enter "t=" and then the ticker symbol.
- CUSIP: Enter "csp=" and then the CUSIP identifier. Entering a CUSIP will return company matches, not individual securities.
- ISIN: Enter "i=" and then the ISIN identifier.
- **SEDOL**: Enter "s=" and then the SEDOL identifier.

Note: When searching for people, you can search by last name only; last name, first name; or first name, last name. Enter your search text in the format: Smith; Smith, John; or John, Smith; respectively.

COUNTRY



Use the following ticker prefixes to limit your search for companies to a specified geographic region. Enter the region code followed by the ticker (e.g., "ust=msft").

- UST=United States
- CDT=Canada
- EUT=Europe
- LACT=Latin America & Caribbean
- APT=Asia
- MEAT=Africa & Middle East

Use the following shortcuts to jump to various pages within company search results. Enter your search string and append the shortcut to it (e.g., "company name-ks" or "t=toy-est").

EXCHANGE



To search by the exchange on which the company trades, you can use the exchange abbreviation to further limit your results. Enter the exchange abbreviation followed by a colon and the ticker (e.g. "nasdaqgs:msft").

Note: All exchange abbreviations in S&P Capital IQ are the standard abbreviations.
